Notification of acceptance will occur within one week of receipt of the request. Notification will be by email with an acknowledgement response requested. If no response is received within 48 hours, a phone call will be placed to the applicant.

Once selected, you will spend up to 80 hours at a CSA approved training site (Samuel Merritt University, CAPE; Little Company of Mary, or Loma Linda University) and be paired with an expert simulation specialist. Together, you will agree on a schedule that meets both of your needs. At the end of the program, after your mentor completes your evaluation, a certificate of completion will be sent you from the CINHC office.

How the CSA benefits

The CSA will maintain a list of qualified instructors and of those who have completed the apprentice program. Upon completion of the apprentice program, the apprentice graduate will agree to be a resource to the CSA to participate in the education of others consistent with their skill and level of expertise.

(Examples of being a resource to the CSA may be to teach a class, lead a committee effort in writing or reviewing scenarios, being a mentor to apprentice others.)
